The Bearcats were ready for their arch rival, Hanceville Bulldogs. After the prior year's loss to the dogs, Cullman was determined to put the Dogs in their place. The game was purely a defensive battle until a 65yd drive made by the Cats with 2:30 left in the half. At Hanceville's 10, Leopard acquired 6 yds on two carries, Patrick went for 2, and Ruehl capped it off with a 2 yd run for the TD. Ronnie Mayhair added the extra point to make it 7-0 at the half. All night long the Dogs could not penetrate the defensive line of the Cats. Finally near the end of the fourth quarter, Hanceville made another surge for a score. Their drive was short lived because Walker intercepted a pass to go 55 yds for a touchdown. Mayhair then completed the extra point to shut the door on the dogs (14-0).

## STRONG DEFENSE CRUSHES KNIGHTS

For the third game of the season, Cullman with a 2-0 record ventured towards Arab for another strong rivalry. The Cats' offense really clicked with Page 13 of 20 for 149 yds and 31 carries for 168 yds; Page passed to Weaver who went 24 yds into the endzone after an 89 yd drive (6-0). Things were pretty dead scoring-wise till the 4th quarter, when Cullman took three plays to go 90 yds on a 69 yd run by Tony Rhuel (12-0). The Knights then threatened at Cullman's 14 but the Bearcats sacked the quarterback twice for a 20 yd loss. Cullman gained possession of the ball. The Cats drove 66 yds for the score on a pass from Page to Hayward. Cullman successfully converted a 2 pt play. Near the end of the game Arab got lucky on a tipped pass to score. The Knights then added a 2 pt play (18-8). The Cats went home with their third straight victory.

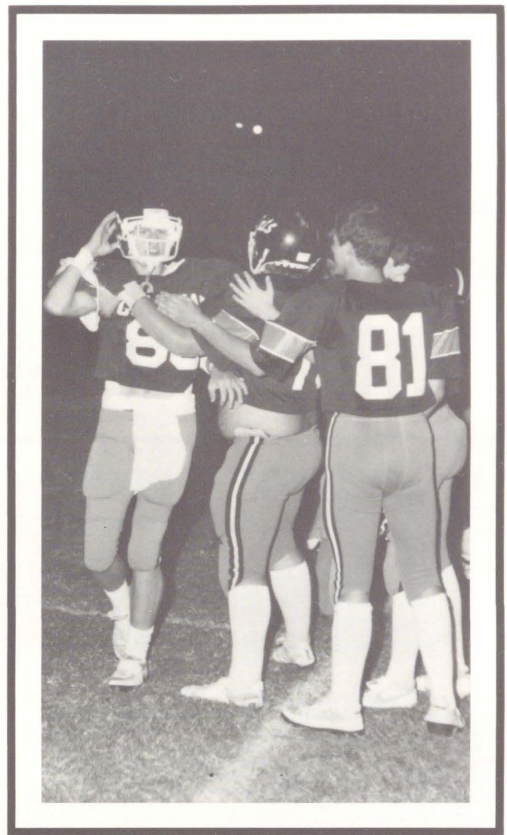






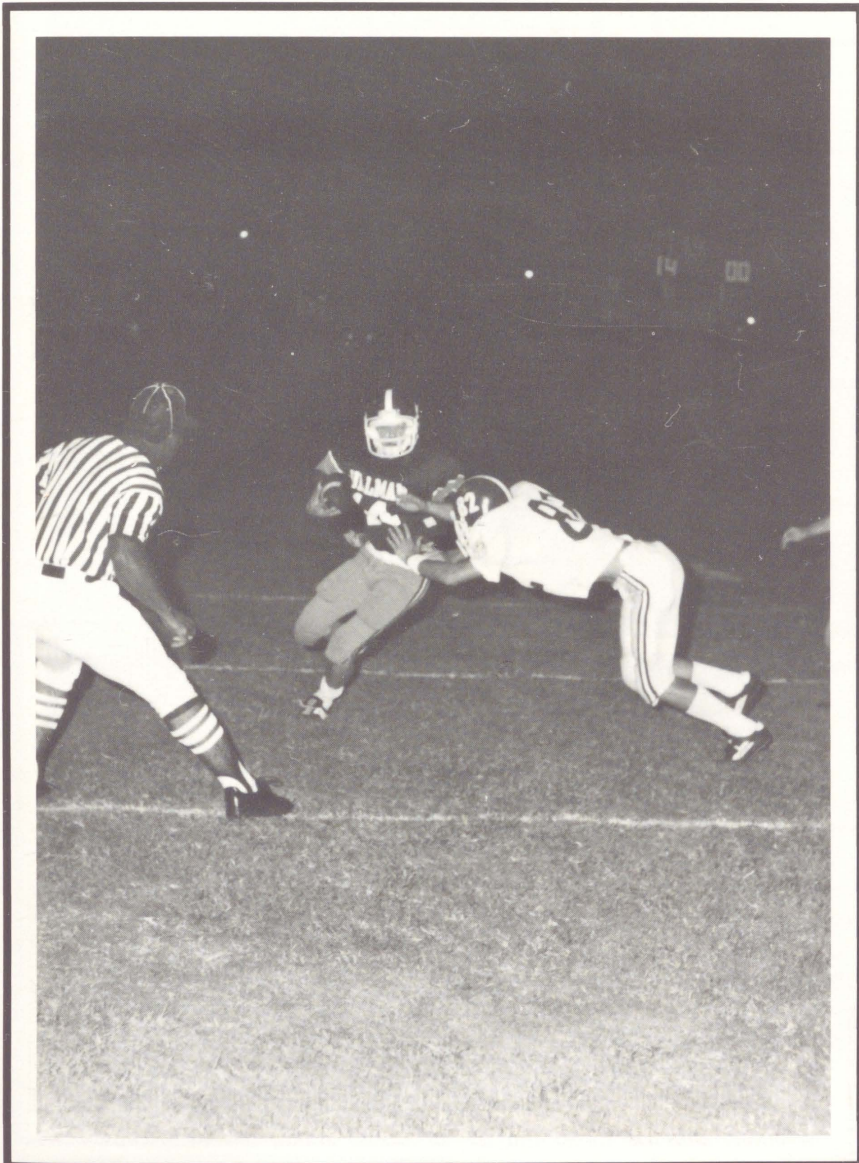
### ATHENS FALLS

### OFFENSE EXPLODES OVER GUNTERSVILLE

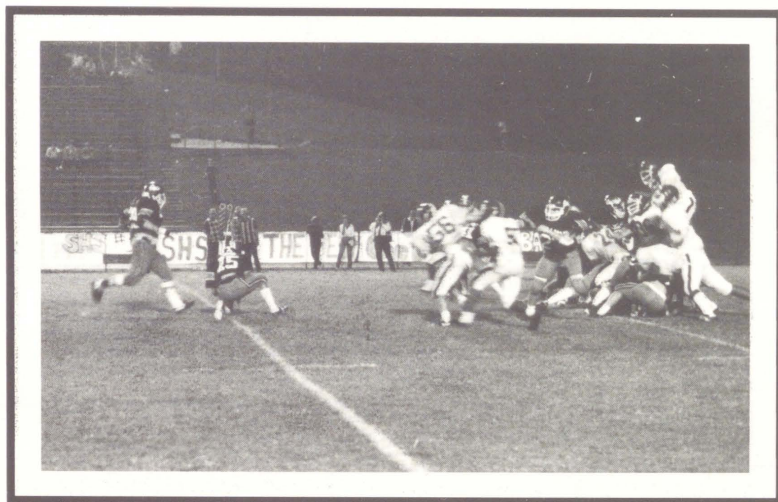
For Homecoming the Bearcats put on the best offensive show of the season against the Guntersville wildcats. There were 358 total offensive yds. gained with 201 yds. on 50 carries and 157 yds. on 8 passes. The Bearcats in the first quarter took the ball 71 yds. on 13 plays to score first 7-0. In late 1st quarter action from the Cullman's 18, Page passed to Weaver who ran for the touchdown 14-0. Cullman then took the ball 66 yds. in 6 plays for their third score. Page ran 22 yds. on the keeper to make it 21-0. With only 6:37 left in the half, Hydrick intercepted a pass and ventured to the endzone 22 yds (27-0). Later game highlights included a punt return by Walker for a touchdown (34-7), and a 13 yd pass to Todd Holmes from Danny Ashley for a TD. Cullman sent the Wildcats home in an embarrassing defeat (40-14).





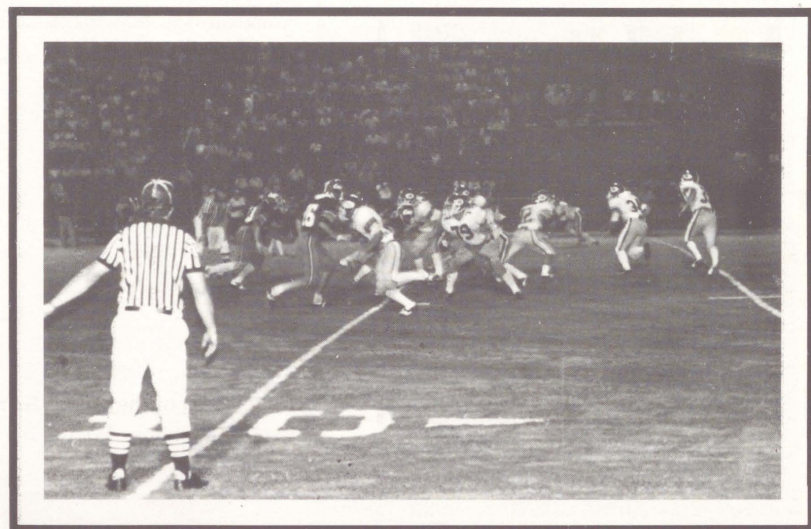
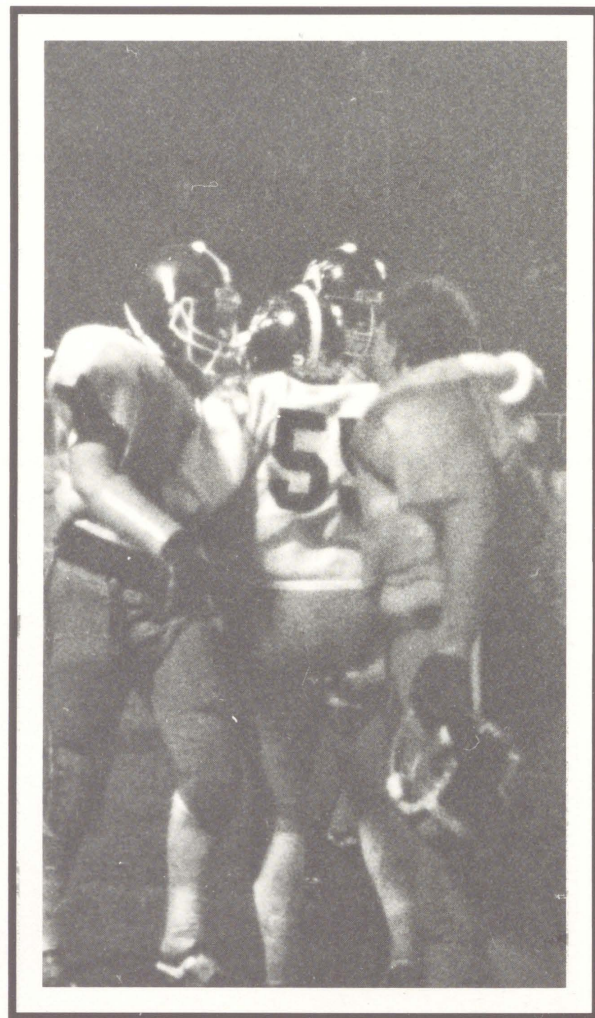
## CULLMAN DAMPENS BREWER'S HOMECOMING

Cullman in a strong defensive show allowed only 39 yds rushing and 79 yds passing during the cold Patriot Homecoming game at Brewer. Leopard struck first on a 5 yd run after a very successful drive in the 1st quarter. Ruehl ran for 50 yds. to the 12 and after two plays went 9 yds into the endzone (12-0). Tony continued the streak for 135 yds. on 25 carries. The second half included two more scores for Cullman. The first ended with a 19 yd play to Hayward and a 2 pt conversion. Brewer came within striking range two plays after to make it 20-14. The Bearcats though held strong to finish out the game on a 1 yd run for a touchdown (26-14).



### 1985's MOST IMPORTANT GAME: CULLMAN VS HARTSELLE

It was a packed stadium for the most important game of the 1985 season. The two undefeated teams with Cullman picked as the underdog met to decide the dispute. Cullman's offense was geared for big plays. Cullman on first possession took the ball from our 21 to their 19. A series of drives ended with Page passing to Hayward for a 9 yd touchdown. In the 2nd quarter Weaver took possession of the ball and traveled 78 yds to visit the Tigers' endzone. Later Mahler received a 7 yd pass from Page and scored after a 60 yd drive to end the third quarter. The Tigers had a chance to win in the 4th, and made it to our 19 before Walker intercepted a pass and ran 64 yds before being stopped. Leopard scored on an 8 yd drive putting the game out of reach (26-14). This probably was the greatest game that ever has been played at Cullman High Stadium.

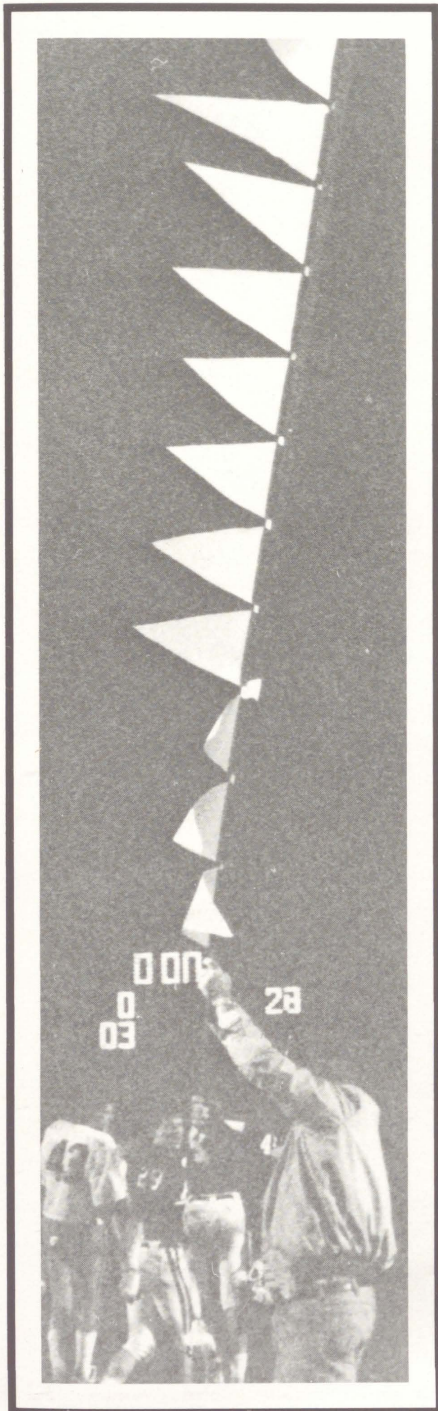






### CULLMAN SHUTS OUT SPARKMAN

Cullman continued to widen the gap with Leopard pulling defenders into the endzone for the 2nd score (14-0). Ashley replaced Page at quarterback and threw to Hayward with 2:19 remaining to seal the victory and the 5A championship (21-0).



### OFFENSE DESTROYS SCOTTSBORO

In first quarter action Cullman was behind for the first time in the season (0-3). Fans were worried when Scottsboro starting quickly scored on their first drive. Things turned around quickly when Shane McMinn playing exceptional defense and intercepted a pass to run 20 yds into the endzone (7-3). In the 2nd quarter Cullman turned on the steam and things fell into place. David Hayward received four touchdown passes from Page who was 10 of 17 for 152 yds (33-0). Scottsboro was history.



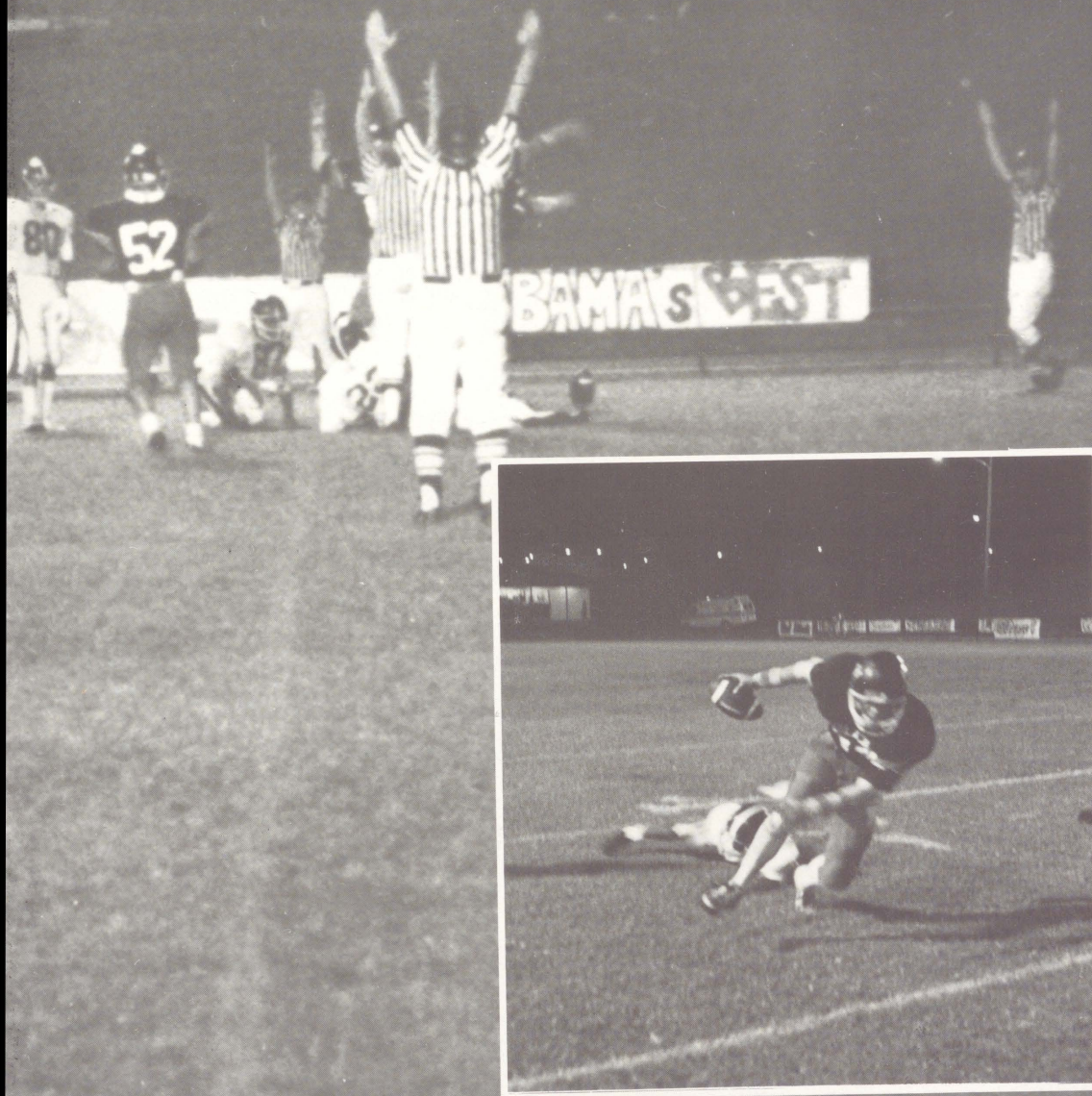
### CATS WIN TENTH

The Cullman Bearcats were bound and determined to beat the Haleyville Lions for the final game of the season. The Cats ran all over the Lion's defense to send their record to 10-0. During the 1st quarter the Lions fumbled four times within their 30 yd line. Cullman could not capitalize on these opportunities until the fourth recovery which ended the first quarter. The first play of the 2nd sent Ruehl on a 2 yd run in for the score. The Cats' next possession started a 82 yd drive that ended with Patrick carrying the ball 4 yds for the TD. Cullman used their first possession of the 2nd half to score on a pass from Page to Hayward. The Bearcats then completed a 2 pt conversion to go up 21-0. At the beginning of the fourth Ashley took over at the Lion's 4 and drove himself into the endzone. Cullman put it out of reach 28-0.









The 1985 season was truly exhilarating. The great football season this year will be remembered. Still important though is a unified spirit that existed and still exists due to the team work of the student body during the football season.
