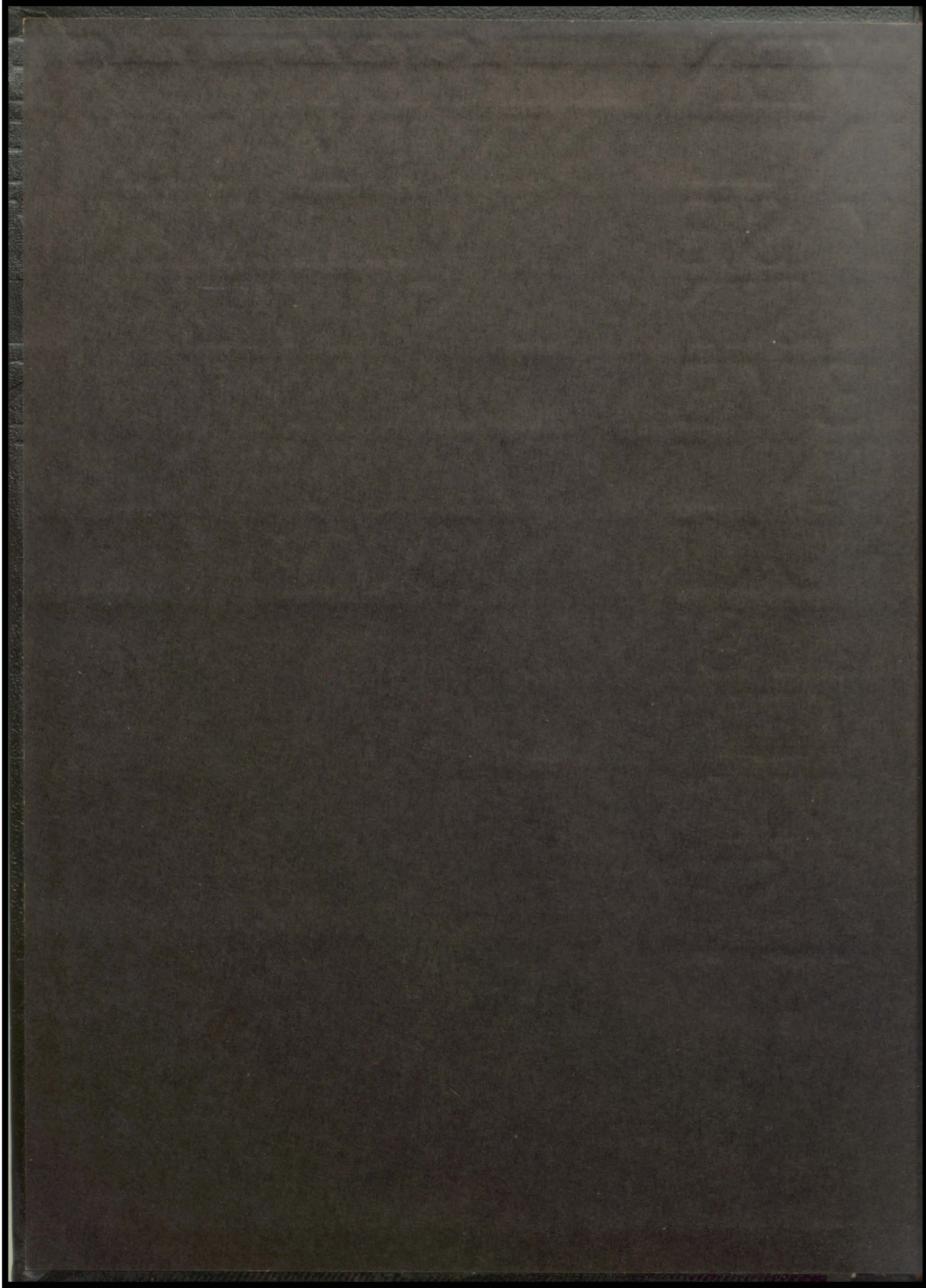


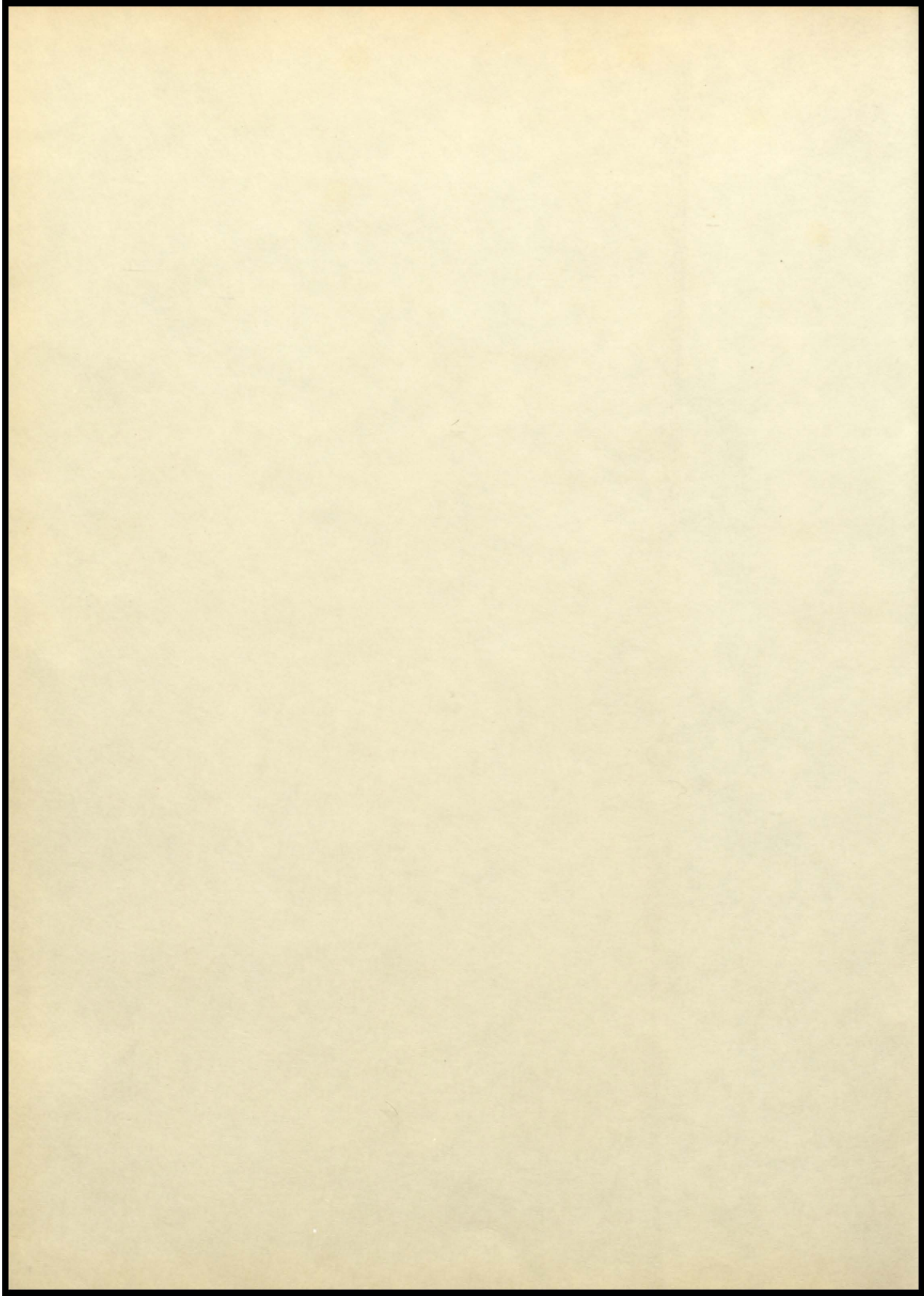

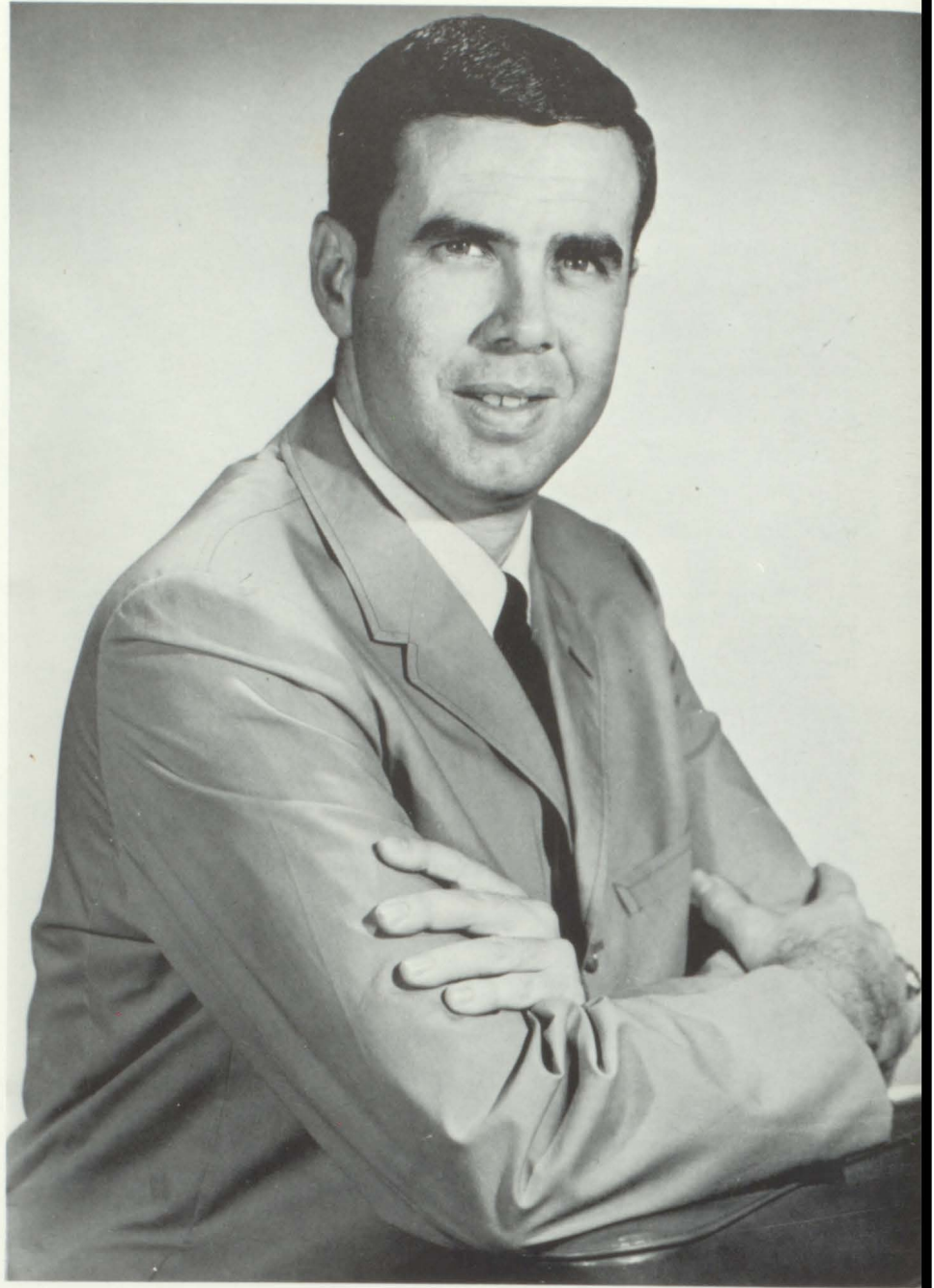


Dedication
