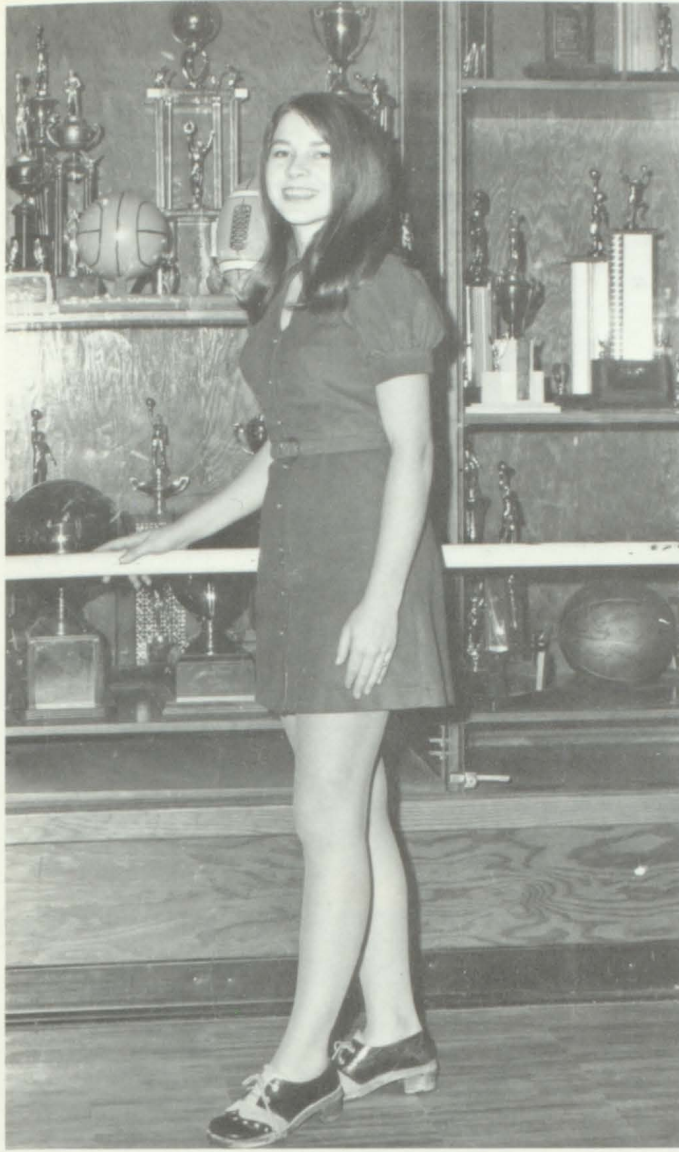
MOST OUTSTANDING ATHLETE
