


Mr. CHS Barrett Lloyd

Johnson put the points on the board for the Bearcats with a plunge from the one yard line. The leadership and initiative from Kane, Armistead, Lloyd, Johnson, Branch, Newcomb, Kevin Kirkwood, Garrett and Handley came up with plays in crucial situations. Robert Kendrick led Cullman's running game with 67 yards on nine carries with David Hays, Patrick, Branch, and Johnson contributing also.

The Bearcats certainly put on a show against the Haleyville Lions. The first play from scrimmage gained the 'Cats 39 yards when Branch connected with Brand right down the middle. A few plays later, Branch fired again, but this time to Newcomb for a 35 yard touchdown. The scoring for Cullman continued with Hays scampering 39 yards for 6 points, Brand dashing 36 yards for six more and Speck running eight yards for another first half score. Johnson pushed his way 13 yards for the fifth Cullman touchdown early in the third quarter and second string quarterback Scott Faulkner darted 48 yards for the sixth and final touchdown for the 'Cats. Haleyville scored late in the fourth quarter but the Bearcats came out on top with a 41-7 victory.






Cullman started off the game on the wrong foot as Huntsville led 7-0 early in the first quarter. However, Johnson scored the first of his three touchdowns from the two yard line during the second quarter. The scoreboard read 7-6 but with just two minutes left before halftime, the 'Cats made it 14-14 as Johnson scored again and Hays ran a two point conversion. During the third quarter action, Johnson once again crossed that goal line and Patrick Little kicked the PAT helping Cullman to a 21-14 lead. The game was not over though as Little kicked a 21 yard field goal completing the scoring leaving the Cats with a 24-14 victory.

Cullman had some crucial mistakes during their game against the Golden Eagles of Athens. Three fumbles and two interceptions did not help the Bearcats to clutch a victory. Athens intercepted a Cullman pass during the first quarter to set them up for an 8-0 lead. Midway through the second period, Athens increased the score to a 15-0 lead. Cullman's first score came in the final seconds of the third period after Armistead intercepted an Athens pass and gave Cullman the ball on the Eagle 21 yard line. The Eagles scored early in the third quarter, making the score 22-0 but the 'Cats were coming on strong. The Bearcats scored when Hays managed to get across the line with 23 seconds remaining. The try for two failed and the score was held at 22-6. A field goal in the last quarter ended the scoring for the Eagles making their final score 29. However, the Bearcats were not finished fighting as Branch connected with Buddy Stewart for a 24 yard scoring pass. An attempt for two failed and left the final score 29-12.



The Cullman Bearcats proved tough until the end as they played their final game of the season against the Butler Rebels. The 'Cats were trailing 14-0 early but came back to close in the gap during the second quarter when Newcomb made a reception in the end zone and Little then kicked the PAT to make it 14-7. However, first half action was not over as Branch sidestepped into the end zone with a few seconds on the clock and narrowed the gap to 14-13 at halftime. The second half was not as enjoyable for the Bearcats as the Rebels continued to push down the field three more times increasing the score to 35-13 in the fourth quarter. Cullman got one last chance though and did not let it by as Brand caught a pass and ran across the goal line. Patrick's PAT completed the scoring and the 1980 season for the Bearcats was over.











Volleyball is a universal game easily adapted to the needs and abilities of all participants. It is a popular participant sport and is fast becoming a popular spectator sport as well.




This game requires a good pass, the precision of a setter, the perfect timing of a hitter plus good serving skill. These three players must be backed up by the other three teammates for a successful game.
